In Taxco we will also visit the major landmarks of the town, including: Santa Prisca Perish, Museum of Lagrimas, Historic Center, Monumental Christ statue, etc.

#### How do I reserve a spot?

#### Is this tour for me?

- During this tour we will be walking on cobble stones, uneven pavement, and dirt roads. You will need to be on your feet and you will have to climb stairs in order to explore most museums, sites, and hotels. Please note that most buildings are old and DO NOT have elevators or ramps
- Walking is inevitable. In addition, you'll have to stand while touring museums and sites.
- Sometimes you will have to sleep with street noise and no (or weak) air conditioning or heater
- Are you a patient person? Service is great in Mexico but it is considered slow per American standards. Meals can take up to 1.5hrs or longer for a large group....patience comes in handy!
