The geography of Guatemala promises to entice the most capricious of traveler's taste – from being the home of the largest Mayan city in Latin America to squeezing two mountain ranges, three active volcanos, to being home of the largest Mayan market. But, there's so much more to experience like its gastronomy and the breath taking architecture of Antigua and Xela. Undoubtedly, Guatemala is a thriving city where in some places time has stopped and yet in others it is consistently evolving.

The Heart of the Mayan World Experience

April 21 – May 1st, 2026

Claudia López, owner and curator of the Guatemalan Boutique will host this all-inclusive travel experience to her home country of Guatemala. Together we will explore Guatemala's Textiles, Gastronomy, Traditions, and Architecture.

In Guatemala City we will visit "*Museo Ixchel del Traje Indígena*", a museum that highlights the history of Guatemalan textiles, this will provide you with an introduction of the Mayan world. We will also explore the National Palace and Popol Vuh Museum, which is home to the finest collection of Mayan royal pottery. Outside of the city, we will visit breath taking Lake Atitlan and the villages of Lake Santiago de Atitlan and

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San Juan La Laguna, where we will taste the best coffee Guatemala has to offer, and we will participate in Huipil demonstrations and we'll learn about the history of textiles and its intricate making.

Another exceptional highlight will be a visit to Chichicastenango, home of the largest Mayan market in all of Central America. We will visit the colonial city of La Antigua, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Our walking tour will include some of the most important sites of the city, including the city center, the central park, Parroquia La Merced, the famous Arch, and other places that you will forever remember.

The final leg of the tour will be held in Peten, Flores – home of Tikal, the Mayan heart. Our private transportation will take us to the airport where we will fly into the Flores airport. In Flores we'll visit Yaxhá & Topoxte, including a boat tour of the Ceibal and Tikal. We will spend three days in Tikal/Flores territory. Upon completion of our third day we will go back to Guatemala City to rest, pack our treasures, and say goodbye to Guate!

The Heart of the Mayan World Tour is 11 days long; the focus is to provide you with an authentic Mayan experience that you can't experience with a large group. The group is limited to 14 participants.

SOFT ITINERARY

Day 1

- Arrive in Guatemala City's International Airport (La Aurora GUA) by 4pm
- Welcome Dinner!

Day 2

- Visit Museo Ixchel del Traje Indígena and the Popol Vuh Museum
- Visit the archeological site of Iximche in the department of Tecpan on our way to Panajachel, home of Lake Atitlan

Day 3

- Early departure to Chichicastenango market: Chichi is a Mayan community with a world famous handicraft market. This is the one place to observe the mix of traditional Mayan rituals inside the Catholic church
- Visit to the beautiful Santo Tomas Hotel in Chichicastenango

Day 4

- Explore the villages of Lake Atitlan
- Board a private boat from Lake Atitlan to the village of San Juan La Laguna, worldwide known for its coffee beans.
- Visit the women's textile cooperative to see hand weaving and the natural dye process to make textiles

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- COFFE BREAK! Taste the best of Guatemala's finest coffee; they also have great hot chocolate if coffee is not your thing.
- Continue to Santiago de Atitlan, where most indigenous habitants still adhere to the traditional lifestyle of the Tz'utuhil Maya. Home of hundreds of painters/artist who collaborate with each other, filling galleries with their oil paintings, which depict market scenes and typical life in the highlands
- Depart to La Antigua

Day 5

- Walking tour of La Antigua. Explore Las Capuchinas Ex-convent, Jade Museum, Chocolate Museum, La Merced, Nim-Po't, Central Park, El Arco de Santa Catalina, etc.

Day 6

- Free day to explore the City of La Antigua at your own pace. Wandering the cobblestones of La Antigua is by far my favorite thing to do when visiting this UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Day 7

- Departure to Guatemala City after breakfast. (Approximately 1.5hrs)
- Visit the town of San Antonio Aguas Calientes
- Explore Guatemala's Central Park and National Palace (*The palace may be closed to visit inside but we will still tour the surroundings)
- Sightseeing some of the most famous buildings in Guatemala from the comfort of our private sprinter van on our way to our hotel
- Traditional Guatemalan Dinner

Day 8

- Early morning departure to La Aurora International airport to catch our flight to Flores, Peten, Guatemala
- Lunch in Flores Island followed by a visit to an animal sanctuary *boat ride

Day 9

- Tour of Tikal – The heart of the Mayan World awaits us. An unforgettable experience in the middle of the jungle. Let's hope to see and hear some wild animals.
- Return to Flores for some time to relax before dinner
- Evening boat ride to our dinner destination

Day 10

- Early Breakfast followed by half day tour of Yaxhá & Topoxte
- Box lunch and Fly back to Guatemala City for dinner
- Goodbye dinner
- Pack your treasures and get a good night sleep

Day 11

- Farewell Guatemala!
- Transport to the airport. Claudia will make all the proper arrangements for you
